GEX 4583 Searchlight Car

To troubleshoot the rotating searchlight mechanism:

- A worm gear on a truck axle turns a gear to spin an assembly inside the car. This
 assembly transfers rotation through a spring to a second wheel assembly to
 which the searchlight is attached.
- 2. Very carefully remove the deck off the car to access the inside assembly. It is glued, and the glued tabs will need to be freed.
- 3. Check that the spring hasn't come loose or broken and reattach if necessary.
- 4. Check that the rotating assemblies can move freely and clean them if necessary.
- 5. Replace the rotating searchlight. If it is missing or broken beyond repair RG Part No. 286 is a modified Lionel housing replacement for the searchlight.

Note: The center post that holds the light socket is thin and can easily break.
